(a) to (d): The erstwhile Air India (AI) had placed an order of 68 Boeing Aircraft in December, 2005 and the erstwhile Indian Airlines (IA) had placed an order for 43 Airbus Aircraft in February, 2006. These orders were mainly placed for replacing ageing fleet, improving schedule integrity etc. Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) registered FIR No. RC-DAI-2013-A-2009 dated 27.02.2013 and FIR No. RC-DAI-2017-A-0020 dated 29.05.2017 on the subject matter and the matter is under investigation with CBI.
