- (a)& (b): The Pradhan Mantri Jan Vikas Karyakram (PMJVK) is a Centrally Sponsored Scheme implemented by this Ministry in 1300 identified Minority Concentration Areas of the country. The proposals are sanctioned by the Ministry and are implemented by State Governments/UT Administrations through the existing state machinery which also includes manpower.
- (c) The Ministry has sanctioned during the period 2014-19, a number of projects under the scheme which includes 25 Degree Colleges, 1152 School Buildings, 20228 Additional Class Rooms, 506 Hostels, 71 ITIs, 5 Polytechnics, 411 Sadbhav Mandaps, 92 Residential Schools, 530 Market Sheds, 5090 Anganwadi Centres, 821 Health Projects, 2285 Water Supply Projects, 11676 Pucca Houses etc. Statewise details of the projects are available on the Ministry's website at http://www.minorityaffairs.gov.in.
