STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF STARRED QUESTION NO. 118 BY SHRI VIJAY KUMAR DUBEY TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 14.12.2022 REGARDING RAIL MITRAS (a) to (d): All Unmanned level crossing (UMLCs) on Broad Gauge (BG) network of Indian Railways have been eliminated by 31.01.2019. Presently, no Rail Mitras (Gate Mitras) deputed on Level Crossings in Uttar Pradesh and Government has no plan to appoint Rail Mitras (Gate Mitras) on permanent basis instead of contractual since deployment of Rail Mitras (Gate Mitras) has since been discontinued

from 2019 onward in Uttar Pradesh.
