(a), (c) & (d) Urban Development is a State subject. Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs facilitates and assists State Governments/ Administration of Union Territories in urban development through its flagship Missions / Schemes - Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) 2.0, Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana - Urban (PMAY-U), Smart Cities Mission (SCM), Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban (SBM-U) 2.0, and Urban Transport (UT). The schemewise details of the financial assistances provided to Government of Odisha under various schemes of the Ministry and funds utilized by State Government during the last five years are given as under:

<u>Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods Mission</u> (DAY-NULM)

District-wise no. of beneficiaries is not maintained under DAY-NULM however, from 2017-18 to 2021-22, in Odisha, 627 urban poor have been imparted skill training to enhance their employability. Loans with the provision of interest subvention have been disbursed to 25,165 beneficiaries for self-employment through individual or group microenterprises. 2,00,543 urban poor have been mobilized into SHGs.

Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT)

District-wise number of beneficiaries is not maintained under AMRUT Mission however the number of beneficiaries benefitted in the state under 24x7 water supply is 2.41 lakh and under sewerage and septage management is 4.14 lakh. The number of beneficiaries benefitted under green spaces and parks is 4.8 lakh so far.
