**AYUSH TREATMENT IN RURAL AREAS**

**\*153. MS. DIYA KUMARI:**

Will the Minister of AYUSH be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of AYUSH treatment facilities available in the rural areas of the country including Rajasthan;
- (b) the funds allocated and released for the same during the last three years;
- (c) the measures taken/being taken by the Government to augment and facilitate the expansion of these facilities in the State of Rajasthan;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to promote the Indian system of medicine internationally due to its affordability and effectiveness in the treatment of chronic diseases; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

**STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO LOK SABHA  
STARRED QUESTION NO. 153\* FOR 16<sup>TH</sup> DECEMBER, 2022**

(a) & (b) The details of AYUSH treatment facilities as being provided through AYUSH dispensaries and co-located AYUSH units at Primary Health Centres (PHCs) & Community Health Centres (CHCs) in the rural areas of the country including Rajasthan is furnished at **Annexure**. As per the proposals received from State/UT Governments through submitted State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) under Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National AYUSH Mission (NAM), an amount of Rs. 39665.38 Lakhs has been allocated/released to them for these AYUSH treatment facilities during the last three years.

(c) Under NAM, Ministry of Ayush is supporting the efforts of State Government of Rajasthan to augment and facilitate the expansion of these facilities in Rajasthan by providing financial assistance under various activities like upgradation of AYUSH Dispensaries, operationalization of AYUSH Health & Wellness Centres (AHWCs) by upgrading AYUSH Dispensaries, co-location of AYUSH facilities at Primary Health Centres (PHCs) & Community Health Centres (CHCs) and supply of essential AYUSH medicines to AYUSH Dispensaries as well as co-located AYUSH units at PHCs & CHCs. Accordingly, State Government may avail financial assistance by submitting suitable proposals through SAAPs as per the provision of NAM guidelines.

(d) & (e) Ministry of Ayush has developed a Central Sector Scheme for the Promotion of International Co-operation in AYUSH (IC Scheme) under which the Ministry of Ayush provides support to Indian AYUSH Manufacturers/ AYUSH Service providers to give boost to the export of AYUSH products & services; facilitates the International promotion, development and recognition of AYUSH system of medicine; foster interaction of stakeholders and market development of AYUSH at international level; promote academics and research through the establishment of AYUSH Academic Chairs in foreign countries and holding training workshop/symposiums for promoting and strengthening awareness and interest about AYUSH Systems of Medicine at international level.
