***157. SHRI N.K. PREMACHANDRAN:**

Will the Minister of AYUSH be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to promote research in Homoeopathy and develop the Homoeopathic Research Institutes;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the current status of opening National Homoeopathy Research Institute in Mental Health, Changnaserri, Kerala;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to develop the National Homoeopathy Research Institute in Mental Health upto International Standard;
- (e) if so, the details of action taken thereon; and
- (f) whether the Government proposes to provide sufficient human resources to the National Homoeopathy Research Institute in Mental Health, Changnaserri and if so, the details thereof?

**STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO LOK SABHA
STARRED QUESTION NO. 157* FOR 16TH DECEMBER, 2022**

(a) & (b) Yes sir. The Central Council for Research in Homoeopathy (CCRH) is an apex research Organization under this Ministry, which undertakes scientific research activities in homoeopathy in the fields of Clinical Research, Drug Proving, Drug Verification, Drug Standardization, Fundamental Research and Epidemic research either in intramural mode or in collaboration with different institutes of repute.

- CCRH has 24 institutes/Units (annexure I) across the country through which the research studies are undertaken in the aforementioned fields.
- CCRH has strengthened its infrastructure in terms of having its own buildings, developing new laboratories, upgrading existing laboratories in terms of equipment for undertaking high end research studies in the areas of clinical, pre-clinical/ fundamental/basic research. In the last five years, the CCRH has augmented/ upgraded its infrastructure to the extent indicated hereunder:

i. Activities completed:

- Regional Research Institute (H), Jaipur, Rajasthan upgraded to Central Research Institute for Homoeopathy.
- Central Research Institute (H) at Kottayam for treating psychiatric diseases has been upgraded to National Homoeopathy Research Institute in Mental Health and also imparting PG course in two subjects viz. Practice of Medicine and Psychiatry with 10 seats each.
- Construction of own combined building for both Regional Research Institute (H) (RRIH) and Regional Research Institute for Unani Medicine (RRIUM) at Mumbai.
- Construction of Hostel block for PG students at NHRIMH, Kottayam.

ii. Availability of Laboratory Facilities:

- Virology laboratory & Animal House at Dr. Anjali Chatterjee Regional Research Institute for Homoeopathy, Kolkata, for undertaking research in Homoeopathy.
- 04 laboratories established at Dr. D P Rastogi Central Research Institute Noida. (Pharmacology lab., Chemistry lab., Botany lab., Microbiology with Animal house for undertaking research in Homoeopathy. These laboratories are responsible for exploring the action of homoeopathic medicines, standardization of raw materials used in Homoeopathy through modern techniques such as HPTLC, spectrometer, spectrophotometer instruments, RTPCR, Elisa reader with BSL-2 lab facilities.)

iii. Strengthening of IT:

Information & Technology based initiatives such as software for recording, providing data on apparently healthy human being, Homoeopathic Clinical Case Repository (HCCR) portal for recording of successfully treated cases with homoeopathy, introduced Ayush Hospital Information and Management System (AHIMS), CCRH e-Library.

(c) No such proposal being contemplated at present. However, CCRH has a national level Institute namely, National Homoeopathy Research Institute in Mental Health (NHRIMH) at Kuruchy, Kottayam, Kerala upgraded from Central Research Institute for Homoeopathy. The Institute conducts PG courses in two subjects viz. Psychiatry and Practice of Medicine with 10 seats each.

(d) to (f): In view of position mentioned at c) above, the question of developing the Institute and providing human resources at Changnaserri do not arise.
