- (b) to (d) Under Swadesh Darshan scheme, administered by Ministry of Tourism, a project for Development of Gwalior-Orcha-Khajuraho-Chanderi-Bhimbetka-Mandu has been sanctioned for Rs. 89.82 Crore under heritage circuit in the state of Madhya Pradesh; which includes development works to the tune of Rs. 34.99 Crore in Khajuraho. The major interventions under the projects include Convention centre, Civil Works, Guest rooms & Cafeteria, Office Building Block, Boundary Wall, Parking Development, Solar Focus Lights, Solar Illumination, Sandstone Benches, Dustbins & Railings and Acoustics. The Project is physically complete.
