SHRIMATI GEETA KORA:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has prepared any schemes/action plan for skill development of youth living below poverty line to skill them and prepare them in accordance with the demand of the labour market, if so, the details thereof, scheme-wise in the country including Jharkhand;
- (b) the total number of youth in the country living below poverty line who are unemployed, State-wise including Jharkhand;
- (c) whether the Government has conducted any survey in this regard and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) the number of functional institutions providing training in skill development in various States, State-wise; and
- (e) the funds allocated to Jharkhand under the said scheme?

DEVELOPMENT OF YOUTH LIVING BELOW POVERTY LINE**

(a) There is no specific scheme for skill development of youth living below poverty line. However, under Skill India Mission, the Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) is imparting long-term and short-term training aligned to requirements of various sectors of the industry. To encourage outcome based skill development training for all youth including those living below poverty line, the Ministry delivers skill-training through a comprehensive network of skill development centres under various schemes viz. Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY), National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS), Jan Shikshan Sansthan (JSS) and Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS) through Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) for the youth across the country. Brief of these schemes is as under:

Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY): PMKVY is a demand-driven Scheme for imparting skill development training through Short-Term Training (STT) and Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) to youth across all States/ Union Territories (UTs).

Jan Shikshan Sansthan (JSS) Scheme: The main target of the JSS is to impart vocational skills to the non-literates, neo-literates and the persons having rudimentary level of education upto 8th standard and school dropouts upto 12th standard in the age group of 15-45 years, with due relaxation in case of "Divyangjan" and other deserving cases. Priority is given to Women, SC, ST, OBC and Minorities.

National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS): This Scheme is for promoting apprenticeship training and increasing the engagement of apprentices by providing financial support to industrial establishments undertaking apprenticeship programme under the Apprentices Act, 1961. Training consists of Basic Training and On-the-Job Training / Practical Training at workplace in the industry.

Craftsmen Training Scheme (CTS): This scheme is for providing long-term training through Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) across the country. The ITIs offer a range of vocational/skill training courses covering a large number of economic sectors with an objective to provide skilled workforce to the industry as well as self employment of youth.

(b) & (c) No data regarding youth living below poverty line who are unemployed is maintained in this Ministry. However, as per the official poverty estimates released by the erstwhile Planning Commission (since been restructured as NITI Aayog), State/Union Territory-wise number and Percentage of Population Below Poverty Line in India 2011-12 (Based on Tendulkar Methodology) is provided in **Annexure-I**.

(d) The State/ Union Territory-wise number of Skill Development Centres under PMKVY, JSS, NAPS, and ITIs as on 30.09.2022 is at **Annexure-II**.

(e) The details of funds released for the State of Jharkhand under PMKVY, JSS, NAPS till date are as under:
