**(a) & (b) Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerments has conducted a Comprehensive National Survey on Extent and Pattern of Substance Use in India through National Drug Dependence Treatment Centre (NDDTC), All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS). The Survey was designed to provide data at the level of States and not at the level of districts.**

**(c) As per latest data published by National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB) pertaining to the year 2021, district-wise cases registered under the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act in the state of Bihar for the last two year 2020 & 2021 is at Annexure-I.**
