PROJECTED EMPLOYMENT UNDER MGNREGS

*198. DR. A. CHELLAKUMAR: ADV. ADOOR PRAKASH:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) is projected to employ people from over 70 million families in Financial Year 2022-2023 indicating that overall economic growth which is still not reaching the rural and unorganised sections of the country;
- (b) whether the Government is aware that as compared to the corresponding pre-COVID month of October 2019, about 15.5 million households applied for jobs through the MGNREGS in October 2022;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (d) whether the Government is aware that in contrast to its two lakh target, the Unnati initiative, which was launched in 2020 to reduce reliance on the MGNREGS, has trained only 25,056 people; and
- (e) if so, the reasons therefor along with the steps taken by the Government to address the issue?

ANSWER MINISTER OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI GIRIRAJ SINGH)

(a) to (e): A statement is laid on the Table of the House.

Statement in reply to Parts (a) to (e) of Lok Sabha Starred Question No. 198 for 20.12.2022

(a)to(c): Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (Mahatma Gandhi NREGS) is a demand driven wage employment Scheme which provides for the enhancement of livelihood security of the households in rural areas of the country by providing at least one hundred days of guaranteed wage employment in every financial year to every household whose adult members volunteer to do unskilled manual work.

In current financial year 2022-23 (as on 15.12.2022), a total of 538.04 lakh households have availed employment under Mahatma Gandhi NREGS.

Details of the households demanded employment in the month of October, 2019 and October, 2022 is given below:

Period	October, 2019	October, 2022
Households demanded employment (in lakh)	129.18	155.45

It provides livelihood security, i.e. fall back options for livelihood for the rural households, when no better employment opportunity is available.

(d) & (e): The Government of India has launched "Project UNNATI" in December 2019 which intends to upgrade the skill-base of the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (Mahatma Gandhi NREGS) workers, and thereby improve their livelihoods, so that they can move from the current partial employment to full employment through either self employment or wage employment. The Project aims to enhance the skill base of 2 lakh Mahatma Gandhi NREGS beneficiaries.

The slow pace of implementation of the "Project UNNATI" at the State level is being regularly reviewed by the Ministry with the State Rural Livelihood Missions of the concerned States. The issue, if any, comes to the notice of this Ministry is addressed immediately. So far, 27,383 (as on 30.11.2022) candidates have been trained.
