CONSTRUCTION OF ANGANWADI CENTRES UNDER MGNREGA

*96. SHRI DHARMENDRA KASHYAP:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Anganwadi Centers (AWCs) constructed under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA) in Uttar Pradesh during the last five years, district-wise;
- (b) the number of AWCs that the Government is planning to construct in Uttar Pradesh during 2022-23, district-wise;
- (c) whether the AWCs have been successful in providing basic health care needs in the most backward districts of Uttar Pradesh during the pandemic; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a) to (d): A statement is laid on the Table of the House.

Statement in reply to Parts (a) to (d) of Lok Sabha Starred Question No. 96 for 13.12.2022

(a): As per Schedule-I of the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (Mahatma Gandhi NREGA), construction of buildings for Anganwadi Centres at the village level or block level is permissible under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (Mahatma Gandhi NREGS).

The district-wise number of Anganwadi Centers (AWCs) completed in the State of Uttar Pradesh under Mahatma Gandhi NREGS during the last five financial years is given at **Annexure-I**.

(b): Mahatma Gandhi NREGS is a demand driven wage employment scheme with bottom up planning. The works are identified, approved and prioritized out of shelf of work by the Gram Panchayat, recommended by Gram Sabha in each State/UT as per the provision of the Act. Accordingly, the works are approved and taken up by Panchayat as per the demand. The planning of works is done as per the estimated person days to be generated for the work in a financial year at the time of assessment of labour budget. **The Ministry does not provide any target or plan for any kind of work to be taken up at the Gram Panchayat level.**

The district-wise number of Anganwadi Centers (AWCs) approved (yet to start) and ongoing as on 07.12.2022 in the State of Uttar Pradesh under Mahatma Gandhi NREGS is given at **Annexure-II**.

(c) & (d): As per the information shared by the Ministry of Women and Child Development, “During the pandemic, all Anganwadi Centres across the country were closed to limit the impact of Covid-19”.
