#### PMMSY in Maharashtra

Will the Minister of **FISHERIES**, **ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING मत्स्यपालन**, पशुपालन और डेयरी मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has reviewed the progress and achievements of Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) which was launched in 2020;
- (b) if so, the details along with the achievements of the Yojana so far;
- (c) the details of additional employment opportunities generated against the targets and also details of income of farmers increased from said scheme so far in various States, State-wise including Maharashtra; and
- (d) the details of funds so far incurred against the budget of the said scheme?

### **ANSWER**

## THE MINISTER OF FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING

#### (SHRI PARSHOTTAM RUPALA)

(a) to (d): The Department of Fisheries, Ministry of Fisheries, Animal Husbandry and Dairying has been reviewing the progress and achievements made by the States/Union Territories and other implementing agencies under Pradhan Mantri Matsya Sampada Yojana (PMMSY) on a regular basis. During last two financial years (2020-21 to 2021-22) and current financial year (2022-23), Department of Fisheries has approved fisheries developmental proposals worth Rs.11030.55 crore, with central share of Rs. 4009.71 crore under PMMSY. Central funds of Rs.1957.43 crore have been released to States/UTs and various implementing agencies under PMMSY.

The major activities approved under PMMSY *inter- alia* include, construction of 14417.83 ha of pond area, 2795 biofloc units, 5000 units of Re-circulatory Aquaculture System (RAS), 24,294 inland cages, 513 fish/shrimp hatcheries, 426 units of deep sea fishing vessels, 1556 units of sea cages, 1690 of ornamental fish rearing units, 55,500 seaweed rafts, 63,731 of monoline tubes for seaweed cultivation, development of 2699.35 ha on integrated fish farming, 22 Fishing Harbours/Fish Landing Centres, 345 units of ice plants/cold storages, 540 units of fish feed mill/plants, 17,535 units of fish transportation facilities, 186 units of fish retail markets,14 disease diagnostic centre & quality testing labs, 4 aquatic referral labs, 3 units of state of art wholesale fish market, 2489 sagar mitras, livelihood & nutritional support to 6,77,462 fishers during ban/lean period. It is estimated that the activities taken up under the PMMSY are likely to create 8,44,032 direct employment opportunities and 25,32,096 indirect employment opportunities and contributing to enhanced income. The state-wise details of estimated employment generation including in Maharashtra is furnished at **Annexure-I**.
