PROMOTION OF FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRY IN JHARKHAND

Will the Minister of FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES be pleased to state:

- (a) the funds allocated by the Government to Jharkhand to promote food processing during the last two years;
- (b) whether the Government is planning to set up a mega food park in Jharkhand and if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) whether the Government has fixed any time limit in this regard and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES (SHRI PRAHLAD SINGH PATEL)

(a): Ministry of Food Processing Industries is implementing a Centrally Sponsored Scheme - PM Formalisation of Micro Food Processing Enterprises (PMFME) for providing financial, technical and business support for upgradation/ setting up micro food processing enterprises. Under the scheme, Rs. 2.68 crores and Rs. 1.73 crores respectively have been released to Government of Jharkhand during FY 2020-21 and FY 2021-22.

No funds are allocated directly to the States in other Central Sector Schemes administered by the Ministry, namely Pradhan Mantri Kisan SAMPADA Yojana & Production Linked Incentive Scheme for Food Processing Industries (PLISFPI).

(b) & (c): Mega Food Parks Scheme under Central Sector Umbrella Scheme, Pradhan Mantri Kisan SAMPADA Yojana (PMKSY) has been discontinued with effect from 01.04.2022 and there are no plans to set up a mega food park in the State of Jharkhand.
