## PROMOTING AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS

(a) whether the Union Government and State Governments are encouraging products related to agriculture, horticulture, dairy, poultry farming etc. by providing financial and technical assistance under any scheme;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether the Government has selected products on the basis of crops, agriculture etc. in all the districts of Haryana including Karnal Parliamentary Constituency for the benefit of farmers and micro entrepreneurs and to promote agricultural export in the State; and

(d) if so, the details thereof?

## ANSWER

(a)&(b): Major schemes providing financial and technical assistance for encouraging products related to agriculture, horticulture, dairy, poultry, farming etc are as follows;

- (i) Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture (MIDH)
- (ii) Paramparagat Krishi Vikas Yojana (PKVY)
- (iii) National Beekeeping and Honey Mission (NBHM)
- (iv) National Bamboo Mission (NBM)
- (v) Mission Organic Value Chain Development for North East (MOVCDNER)
- (vi) Rashtriya Gokul Mission(RGM)
- (vii) National Programme for Dairy Development (NPDD)

- (viii) Dairy Processing and Infrastructure Development Fund(DIDF)
- (ix) Supporting Dairy Cooperatives and Farmer Producer Organizations engaged in dairy activities (SDC&FPO)
- (x) National Livestock Mission(NLM)

(c)&(d): Government of India has approved One District One Product (ODOP) for identified products in 728 districts of the country. Department of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare is implementing the programme as One District One Focus Produce (ODOFP) by converging resources from the schemes of the department to support identified products in the districts. Further, Ministry of Food Processing Industries through the Prime Minister - Formalisation of Micro Food Processing Enterprises (PM-FME) scheme, being implemented under Atmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyan, aims at supporting 2 lakh micro food processing units with credit linked subsidy with a total outlay of Rs.10,000 crore over the period 2020-2025. 137 unique products have been identified and approved as One District One Product (ODOP) across 713 districts in the country including districts of Haryana, for development of respective value chains. Milk Based Product has been selected as ODOP for Karnal District of Haryana. Also, in the Agricultural Export Policy (AEP) of the Government of Haryana which is being formulated, Karnal district has been included for the promotion of value added products of Rice and Wheat.

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
