DAIRY DEVELOPMENT POLICY

1121. SHRI T.R. BAALU:

Will the Minister of FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING मत्स्यपालन, पशुपालन और डेयरी मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that only ten States in the country produce 81 percent of the total milk produced and only nine States have achieved per capita availability of milk at par with the national level; and
- (b) if so, the action taken/being taken by the Government to devise a suitable dairy development policy for enhancing milk production and procurement in the remaining potential districts and States?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING (SHRI PARSHOTTAM RUPALA)

- (a) As per information available with the Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying (Statistics Division), ten states in the country produce 81.67 % of the total milk produced. Ten States have achieved per capita availability of milk at par with national level.
- (b) In order to complement and supplement the efforts of the States and UTs, the Department of Animal Husbandry & Dairying, Government of India is implementing following animal husbandry and dairy development schemes for strengthening infrastructure across the country for enhancing milk production and procurement in the potential districts and States:
- (i) National Programme for Dairy Development (NPDD)
- (ii) Dairy Processing and Infrastructure Development Fund (DIDF)
- (iii) Supporting Dairy Cooperatives and Farmer Producer Organizations engaged in dairy activities (SDCFPO)
- (iv) Rashtriya Gokul Mission (RGM)
- (v) National Livestock Mission (NLM)
- (vi) Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund (AHIDF)
