**INDIA BPO PROMOTION SCHEME**

**1233. SHRI RAJENDRA AGRAWAL:**

Will the Minister of ELECTRONICS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of BPOs which have been set up under India BPO Promotion Scheme during the last two years, State/UT-wise;
- (b) the total number of people employed under the scheme;
- (c) whether the Government is planning to expand the rural BPO scheme so that participation of women and persons with disability would increase; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

**ANSWER**

(a): The Government of India's objective is to take up digital opportunities in the small cities and towns across the country to create employment opportunities in Information Technology/ Information Technology Enabled Services (IT/ITES) Sector. In this connection, the Government had launched India BPO promotion scheme (IBPS), under Digital India Program in 2016. Under IBPS, 227 BPO/ITES have set up BPO/ITES operations in 93 cities/towns of 21 State/UTs across the country. State/UT wise details is at *Annexure*.

The duration to invite new bids under IBPS was up to 31.03.2019. Therefore, no new BPO/ITES unit is allocated under IBPS in last two years.

(b): The units under IBPS have reported direct employment to 50,757 persons.

(c): No Sir. Presently, there is no such proposal under consideration.

(d): Does not arise.
