(a) the details of trains running between Bangalore and Hubballi, Phaltan and Pune and Latur and Mumbai at present;

(b) whether any new train has been introduced in these places during the last two decades;

(c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and

(d) the fresh steps taken by the Government to introduce new trains between these places keeping in view of the multi-fold increase in passenger traffic on these routes?

(a) At present, Bengaluru-Hubballi sector is served by 29 pairs of trains,

Mumbai-Latur sector by 03 pairs of trains while one pair of passenger

special serves Pune-Phaltan sector.

(b) to (d) Introduction of train services is an ongoing process on Indian

Railways, subject to operational feasibility, traffic pattern, availability

of resources, etc. Accordingly, 18 pairs of trains have been introduced

on Bengaluru-Hubballi, 3 pairs on Mumbai-Latur and 02 pairs on Pune-

Lonand-Phaltan sector during 2003-2022 (till November 2022). Besides,

Indian Railways also operate special trains to clear extra passenger

traffic during festivals, peak season, holidays etc.
