**(a): A State-wise statement showing the amount of distribution of foodgrains under Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana (PM-GKAY) is at Annexure-I.**

**(b)& (c): Under the Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana (PM-GKAY), the Department has allocated foodgrains to all States/UTs for additional free-of-cost distribution of foodgrains to around 80 Crore National Food Security Act (NFSA) beneficiaries in the country, including 5.01 crore NFSA beneficiaries of Madhya Pradesh. Total 1,118 LMT foodgrains have been allocated under PM-GKAY with a total financial outlay of approximately Rs. 3.91 Lakh Crore for all States/UTs across the country. The district-wise details of beneficiaries/people of Madhya Pradesh covered under NFSA and PMGKAY, as conveyed by the State Government, is at Annexure-II. Around Rs. 19,000 crore, which is the approximate financial burden for distribution of free of cost foodgrains under PMGKAY in Madhya Pradesh, has been entirely borne by the Government of India. There is no financial burden on States/UTs for distribution of foodgrains under PMGKAY. District wise details of foodgrain distribution under PMGKAY for Madhya Pradesh is at Annexure-III.**
