Assistance from other Countries

1267. SHRI DULAL CHANDRA GOSWAMI:

Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

- (a) the names of the countries providing assistance to India for meeting its nuclear energy related requirements at present;
- (b) the number of countries with which India has signed agreements for uninterrupted supply of Uranium; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR PERSONNEL, PUBLIC GRIEVANCES & PENSIONS AND PRIME MINISTER'S OFFICE (Dr. JITENDRA SINGH):

- (a) At present, Russia, Canada, Kazakhstan and Uzbekistan are providing assistance to India for meeting its nuclear energy related requirements.
- (b) & (c) Government has agreement with Government of Russian Federation for supply of Fuel for Russian Reactors at Kudankulam Nuclear Power Project (KKNPP) throughout its operation. India entered into Uranium Purchase Agreement with Canada, Kazakhstan, Russia and Uzbekistan.
