MOBILE NETWORK COVERAGE IN TRIBAL AREAS

1310. SHRI ADALA PRABHAKARA REDDY:

Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has achieved 100% mobile network coverage in all tribal areas of the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) the details of the tribal areas not having mobile network coverage till date, State-wise; and
- (d) the steps taken by the Government to ensure 100% mobile network coverage in all tribal areas?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI DEVUSINH CHAUHAN)

- (a) to (c) As per data provided from Telecom Service Providers (TSPs), Department of Telecom's field unit and State Governments as of March '2022, out of 1,20,613 villages (villages are as per data of Registrar General of India as of November 2019), with more than 25% tribal population in respective districts, around 1,00,030 (83%) number of villages are having mobile network coverage and 20,583 villages are not having any mobile coverage. The reasons for not having mobile network in these villages include, inter-alia, remote and tough terrain, areas diversely located with scattered population and commercially non-viable operations. The Union Cabinet has approved a project for 4G mobile coverage saturation to cover all such uncovered villages. The State/UT wise details of status of mobile network coverage in tribal area of the country is attached as **Annexure-I.**
- (d) Government and Telecom Service Providers (TSPs) provide telecommunication connectivity in the country in a phased manner. Government through funding from Universal Service Obligation Fund (USOF) is implementing various schemes for providing mobile network coverage in all remaining uncovered villages of the country including the villages of tribal areas to achieve 100% coverage.
