#### **GRAM UJALA PROGRAMME**

Will the Minister of POWER be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the States where Gram Ujala Programme has been implemented/proposed to be implemented;
- (b) whether the Prayagraj region of Uttar Pradesh has been identified for implementation of first phase of Gram Ujala Programme;
- (c) if so, the details thereof along with outcomes in this regard especially in Uttar Pradesh;
- (d) the steps taken/being taken to create awareness about the said programme among the beneficiaries;
- (e) whether the Government proposes to implement second phase of Gram Ujala programme;
- (f) if so, the details thereof; and
- (g) the time by which it is likely to be started?

#### ANSWER

#### THE MINISTER OF POWER AND NEW & RENEWABLE ENERGY

(SHRI R.K. SINGH)

- (a): Gram Ujala scheme has been implemented by Convergence Energy Services Limited (CESL), in the States of Bihar, Uttar Pradesh, Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka and Telengana on Pilot basis.
- (b) & (c): Prayagraj area was identified in the first phase for implementation of Gram Ujala Programme. A total number of 46,34,219 LEDs bulbs were distributed in Uttar Pradesh, out of which 1,36,375 number of LEDs bulbs were distributed in Prayagraj under this programme.
- (d): Various awareness activities are being done by CESL/authorized agencies for the usage of LED bulbs amongst beneficiaries such as local /national media outreach, information dissemination through radio/TV and other modes of media like banners, posters, leaflets etc.
- (e) to (g): Expansion of Gram Ujala by CESL would depend upon the success of the Pilot phase in terms of financial viability.
