GRID CONNECTED ROOFTOP SOLAR PROGRAMME

Will the Minister of NEW AND RENEWABLE ENERGY be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any demand has been received from DISCOMs of Maharashtra for Grid Connected Rooftop Solar programme during the current year and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the capacity allocated to Maharashtra for installation of rooftop solar system in the residential sector during the current year;
- (c) the installed capacity reported in Maharashtra during the current year; and
- (d) the quantum of Central Financial Assistance (CFA) given to the State of Maharashtra during the current year?

(a) to (d) The Ministry of New and Renewable Energy is presently implementing Rooftop Solar Programme Ph-II under which central financial support is provided for residential sector. The capacities under the Programme are allocated to the state implementing agencies based on the demand received from them. During current financial year no demand has been received from the DISCOMs of Maharashtra for allocation of capacities under the Programme.

In current financial year an aggregate rooftop solar capacity of 325.96 MW has been reported installed in the state by various DISCOMs of the Maharashtra.

During the current financial year, a total central financial support of Rs. 18.4 Cr. has been released to state implementing agencies of Maharashtra under Rooftop Solar Programme against previous allocations.
