### NO.1506. DR. CHANDRA SEN JADON:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has implemented the Scheme for Development of satellite towns around seven megacities in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to expand the coverage of the said scheme by connecting more cities in the country;
- (d) if so, the details thereof, State-wise including Ferozabad, Uttar Pradesh;
- (e) whether the Government has received proposals from various States for inclusion of thecities under this scheme;
- (f) if so, the details thereof; and
- (g) the steps being taken by the Government to develop small towns into cities in the country?

(a)& (b) :Yes Sir, the pilot scheme of Urban Infrastructure Development Scheme for Satellite Towns around seven mega cities (UIDSST), viz.
Pilkhuwa (Uttar Pradesh), Vikarabad (Telangana), Sonepat (Haryana), Vasai-Virar (Maharashtra), Sriperumbudur (Tamil Nadu), Sanand (Gujarat) and Hoskote (Karnataka) was implemented from 2009-10 to 2017-2018. It aimed at providing basic urban infrastructure in these selected towns with the overall objective of ameliorating pressure on mega cities. The total amount released by the Central Government is ₹ 459.70 Crore.
