**Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether it has come to the notice of the Union Government that the State Government of Telangana has taken up 2nd phase of Hyderabad Metro from Mindspace to Shamshabad international airport of 32 kms;**
- (b) whether the Union Government is also aware that the expenditure on the project comes to Rs. 6,250 crores;**
- (c) if so, whether the Union Government has received request from the State Government of Telangana for providing financial assistance to the second phase of the project; and**
- (d) if so, the details thereof?**

**(a) & (b): Yes sir, Government of Telangana State (GoTS) has planned a metro corridor from Raidurg Station to Shamshabad International Airport covering a length of 31 km at an estimated cost ₹6,105 cr as a fully state owned project.**

**(c) & (d): GoTS has requested for financial support from Government of India under 50:50 Equity Share model of Metro Rail Policy, 2017 for another metro corridor project from BHEL to Lakdikapul (26 km) and between Nagole and LB Nagar (5 km) with an estimated cost of ₹ 8,453 cr.**
