## GOVERNMENT OF INDIA MINISTRY OF POWER LOK SABHA UNSTARRED QUESTION NO.1550 ANSWERED ON 15.12.2022

### HYDROELECTRIC POWER PRODUCTION

#### **1550. SHRI INDRA HANG SUBBA:**

Will the Minister of POWER be pleased to state:

(a) the details of hydroelectric power production in each State of the country during the last five years, State/UT and year-wise;

(b) the quantum of surplus electricity generated in the country; and

(c) the policy interventions done by the Government during the last five years to improve electricity production from clean sources?

### ANSWER

#### THE MINISTER OF POWER AND NEW & RENEWABLE ENERGY

(SHRI R.K. SINGH)

(a) : State/UT-wise details of hydroelectric power production in the country during the last five years and the current year are given at Annexure.

(b): Generation is based on the demand of power. The actual generation from hydro projects during the years 2017-18, 2018-19, 2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22 was 89.28%, 103.76% 113.76%, 107.08% and 101.39% of the target.

(c): The following measures have been taken to promote renewable energy in the country:

- Declaration of a Renewable Purchase Obligation (RPO) trajectory up to the year 2029-30.
- Waiver of Inter State Transmission System (ISTS) charges for solar, wind and hydro projects.

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- Setting up of Ultra Mega Renewable Energy to provide land and transmission to RE developers on a plug and play basis.
- Schemes such as Pradhan Mantri Kisan Urja Suraksha evam Utthaan Mahabhiyan (PM-KUSUM), Solar Rooftop Phase II, 12000 MW CPSU Scheme Phase II.
- Laying of new transmission lines and creating sub-stations capacity under the Green Energy Corridor Scheme for evacuation of renewable power.
- Notification of standards for deployment of solar photovoltaic system/devices.
- Setting up of Project Development Cell for attracting and facilitating investments.
- Permitting of Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) under the automatic route.
- Standard Bidding Guidelines for tariff based competitive bidding process for procurement of power from Grid Connected Solar PV and Wind.
- Government has issued orders that power shall be dispatched against Letter of Credit (LC) or advance payment to ensure timely payment by distribution licensees to RE generators.
- Notification of Promoting Renewable Energy through Green Energy Open Access Rules 2022.
- Launch of Green Term Ahead Market (GTAM) and Green Day Ahead Market (GDAM) to facilitate sale of Renewable Energy through exchanges.
- Declaration of Large Hydro Power (LHPs) (> 25 MW projects) as Renewable Energy sources.
- Provision of budgetary support for Flood Moderation and enabling Infrastructure, i.e. roads/bridges of Hydro Electric Projects (HEPs).
