Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:-

- (a) the details of the funds spent on Jal Shakti Abhiyan and Catch the Rain Campaign since its inception, State/UT-wise; and
- (b) the details of percentage of funds spent on the advertisement of the aforementioned scheme out of the total money spent on it, year and State-wise?

ANSWER

(a) Jal Shakti Abhiyan-I (JSA-I) was conducted in 2019 in 1592 blocks out of 2836 blocks in 256 water stressed districts of the country. Jal Shakti Abhiyan: Catch the Rain (JSA:CTR) campaign 2021 was launched on 22.03.2021 & JSA:CTR 2022 was launched on 29.03.2022. No separate funds have been allocated for JSA:CTR campaigns. Funds spent under the JSA:CTR Campaigns is inter-sectoral convergence of various development programmes/ schemes of Central and State Governments. However, Financial assistance of Rs. 2.00 lakh is released to each district in two installments of Rs. 1.00 lakh each for GIS mapping of water bodies and preparation of scientific water conservation plans under JSA:CTR. The state-wise details of funds released under JSA:CTR for GIS mapping of water bodies and preparation of scientific water conservation plans are at **Annexure-I**. The state-wise details of expenditure from Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) under JSA:CTR, as uploaded on JSA:CTR Portal (jsactr.mowr.gov.in) for JSA:CTR and JSA:CTR-2022 campaigns are at **Annexure II & Annexure III** respectively.

(b) Department of Water Resources, RD & GR, Ministry of Jal Shakti which is the nodal Department for implementation of JSA:CTR campaigns, has not spent any funds on advertisement for the aforementioned campaigns.
