ALLOTMENT OF SLOTS FOR AIRLINE

- (a) whether the Government has any mechanism to analyse the utilisation of allotted slots of each airline and if so, the details of the method adopted therefor;
(b) if not, whether the Government proposes to implement the same in future and if so, the details thereof;
(c) the details of slots allotted to various airlines at Calicut airport; and
(d) whether the Government is aware that these allotted slots in airports are not being properly utilised by the airlines and, if so, the details thereof alongwith the action taken in this regard?

(a) & (b): The Ministry of Civil Aviation has formulated Guidelines for Slot Allocation for fair and transparent distribution of slots. Accordingly, Slot Allocation Committee's meetings are held by Airport Operators twice a year for allocating the slots to airlines for the Summer and Winter Schedule. These schedules are made available in the public domain on the website of Directorate General of Civil Aviation.

(c): The details of slots allotted per week (arrival + departure) to various airlines at Kozhidoor airport are as under:

(d): Slot allocation is a regular process held twice a year based on the Committee's meetings and unutilized slots (if any) of any Schedule are reviewed/ addressed in the subsequent meetings and allocated to interested airlines.
