(a) The year-wise volume of cargo handled through Paradip Port of Odisha during the last five years is as under :

No Major Port including Paradip Port is maintaining data on trade value.

(b) The details of major trade routes served by the Paradip Port is as under:

1.	POL (Products)	Coastal – All Major Ports Foreign – Bangladesh, Japan, China, Malaysia, Singapore, Mauritius
2.	POL (Crude Oil)	Foreign – Serving Angola, Iraq, Mexico, Nigeria, Saudi Arabia, UAE, USA, Kuwait, Congo

3.	Thermal Coal	Coastal – Ennore, Krishnapatnam, Tuticorin, Karaikal
4.	Iron Ore/ Pellets	Coastal – Hajira, Jaigarh Foreign – China, Indonesia, Malaysia, Oman, Spain.
5.	Import Coal	Foreign – Australia, Indonesia, Mozambique, South Africa, Russia.
6.	Fertilizer/ Fertilizer Raw Material	Foreign – China, Jordan, Morocco, Vietnam, Egypt, UAE, Western Sahara, Kuwait.
7.	Container	Coastal – Haldia, Chennai, Tuticorin, Hajira.
