DEVELOPMENT OF WATER TRANSPORT

1621. SHRI ANTO ANTONY:

Will the Minister of PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS be pleased to state पत्तन, पोत परिवहन और जलमार्ग मंत्री

- (a) whether the Government of Kerala has submitted any report on the development of water transport in the State;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the response of the Government thereto:
- (c) whether the Government has declared some waterways as National Waterways in the country;
- (d) if so, the details of such waterways and the present stage of their implementation; State-wise;
- (e) whether the Government has any plan to develop more waterways in the country; and
- (f) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF PORTS, SHIPPING AND WATERWAYS (SHRI SARBANANDA SONOWAL)

(a)& (b) No Sir. Govt. of Kerala has not submitted any report on the development of water transport in the State. However, Govt of Kerala has requested in September 2022 for initiating steps to declare the Kovalam to Kollam and Kozhikode to Bakel stretches of West Coast Canal as appropriate clause (Class-I/ Class-III) of National Waterway.

National Waterway-3 (NW-3) in Kerala from Kottapuram to Kozhikode was extended vide National Waterways Act, 2016. Inland Waterways Authority of India (IWAI) is focusing on the development of technically and economically viable declared stretches of NW-3 and at present further extension is not feasible.

(c) & (d) Yes, Sir. To promote Inland Water Transport (IWT) in the country, 111 Waterways (including 5 existing and 106 new) spread over 24 states have been declared as National Waterways under the National Waterways Act, 2016. Based on the outcome of techno-economic feasibility and Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) of the

NWs, action plan formulated for 26 NWs which have been found viable for cargo /passenger movement. Details of 26 NWs is at **Annexure-1**.

(e) & (f) At present focus of the Government is on completion/operationalization of the declared viable NWs as explained above and development of more National Waterways in subsequent phases.
