SETTING UP OF AYUSH MEDICAL CENTRES

1690. SHRIMATI VEENA DEVI:

Will the Minister of **AYUSH** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether AYUSH medical centers have been established in rural areas and if so, State-wise and district-wise details there of;
- (b) the number of Post Graduate colleges of AYUSH in Bihar;
- (c) whether Homoeopathy, Ayurvedic and Unani Medical Health Centres are functioning in the rural areas of Bihar; and
- (d) if so, the district-wise details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

**ANSWER
THE MINISTER OF AYUSH
(SHRI SARBANANDA SONOWAL)**

(a): Public Health being a State subject, establishment of AYUSH medical centre in rural areas comes under purview of respective State/UT Governments. However, under Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National AYUSH Mission (NAM), there is provision of financial assistance for setting up of 50 /30 /10 bedded integrated AYUSH hospitals and establishment of new AYUSH dispensary in the area where there are no AYUSH facilities available. Accordingly, the State/UT Government may avail financial assistance by submitting suitable proposals through State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs). Under NAM, as per the proposals received from States/UTs through SAAPs, the State/UT-wise details of approved integrated AYUSH hospitals in the country are furnished at **Annexure-I**.

(b): Two Post Graduate colleges of AYUSH in Bihar are functioning.

(c) & (d): Yes, the district-wise details Homoeopathy, Ayurvedic and Unani Dispensaries as functioning in the Bihar are furnished at **Annexure-II**.
