- (a): The data of PM Scholarship is maintained Zila Sainik Board -wise. Grant of PM Scholarship Scheme from Andhra Pradesh for last four years, Zila Sainik Board-wise, gender-wise degree level-wise is placed at Annexure-I.
- (b) & (c): Yes, Sir. The PM Scholarships is merit based grant to the selected students. The initial payment is made on the basis of proof of admission and subsequent payment are subject to successful passing of each semester in the first attempt with minimum 50% aggregate of marks.
