KIDNEY PROBLEM IN ANDHRA PRADESH

Will the **Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has taken steps/ proposes to take steps to promote the Peritoneal Dialysis under the Prime Minister National Dialysis Program (PMNDP);
- (b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- (c) the number of patients suffering from kidney diseases in Andhra Pradesh availing the services of Peritoneal Dialysis under the PMNDP, district-wise; and
- (d) the number of patients availing the services of Peritoneal Dialysis under the PMNDP for the last three years and current year, State/UT/district-wise?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

(a) to (d): Pradhan Mantri National Dialysis Programme (PMNDP) has been launched by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare for chronic kidney disease to provide haemodialysis services during year 2016-17 under National Health Mission (NHM). PMNDP has been implemented in total 36 States/UT in 630 Districts. Peritoneal Dialysis has also been included from 2020 onwards.

In state of Andhra Pradesh, haemodialysis under PMNDP is implemented in all 13 districts at 39 centres. The State Government of Andhra Pradesh had issued the instructions to the Medical Colleges to counsel the patients on peritoneal dialysis. The Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India had provided support to Government of Andhra Pradesh for peritoneal dialysis services to three Medical Colleges at Vishakhapatnam, Tirupathi and Guntur under National Health Mission in 2022-24.
