**HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES**

SHRI ARJUN LAL MEENA:**

Will the Minister of **HEALTH & FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government under the Central Sector Scheme, 'Human Resource Development for Emergency Medical Services', has proposed to set up Skill Centres in Government medical colleges across the country to impart skills on life saving interventions;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the quantum of funds sanctioned, released and utilized for the same as of November 2022, State/UT-wise;
- (c) the number of medical colleges that have been granted funds under the said scheme, medical college-wise/State/UT-wise including Rajasthan;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to sanction and release funds for setting up of Skill Centres in Medical colleges of Bharatpur, Bhilwara, Churu, Dungarpur and Jhalawar under the said scheme and if so, the details thereof along with the time by which such funds and likely to be released; and
- (e) if not, the reasons therefor?

**ANSWER**

- (a) to (e): Central Sector Scheme, 'Human Resource Development for Emergency Medical Services' is intended to create a pool of trained doctors, nurses and paramedics in the country with skills on life saving interventions. The said scheme provides for setting up and equipping Skill Centres in Medical Colleges/ Institution along with development of standardized course materials for training of doctors, nurses and paramedics.

State/UT wise details of funds released for developing infrastructure and procurement of training equipment is at **Annexure I**.

State/UT wise details of medical colleges that have been granted funds under the said scheme including Rajasthan is at **Annexure II**.

State Governments are requested to send the proposal for consideration of Medical Colleges under the scheme. After inspection by the technical committee duly ensuring wider geographical representation across the country, the skill centres under the scheme are approved. A total of eight Medical Colleges including Bharatpur have been approved under the scheme in the State of Rajasthan. The proposal for, Bhilwara, Churu, Dungarpur and Jhalawar have also been received from State government.
