RESERVATION OF HOSPITAL'S BEDS

1778. SHRI GIRIDHARI YADAV:

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether as per the guidelines of MCI (currently NMC), it is mandatory to reserve 10 per cent of total bed capacity for ICU in all the hospitals in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the total number of beds available in government hospitals across the country including the ICU beds; and
- (c) the time by which the Government proposes to make ICU beds available as per the norms?

(a) to (c): As per Minimum Requirements for Annual MBBS Admissions Regulations, 2020, the requirement for beds in Intensive Care Unit (ICU), including Intensive Coronary Care Unit (ICCU), Surgical ICU, Paediatric ICU and Neonatal ICU and Obstetric HUD/ ICU are as under:-

Annual MBBS student intake	ICU beds required
100	30
150	60
200	90
250	120

It is primarily responsibility of State governments/Union Territories to make available sufficient number of beds as per need. As per National Health Profile 2021, the State/ UT wise details of total number of beds available in government hospitals has been placed at Annexure.
