(a) & (b): Under the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY), setting up of 22 All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) across the country has been approved with the objective of providing tertiary care health services in Speciality Departments and Super Speciality Departments. Under the scheme 75 projects of upgradation of Government Medical Colleges (GMCs) by way of setting up of Super Speciality Blocks has also been approved. In AIIMS Kalyani currently OPD and 150 bed IPD bed facility is operational.

(c) & (d): The mechanism regarding bed availability is available in AIIMS New Delhi, AIIMS Kalyani, AIIMS, Bhopal, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar, AIIMS, Jodhpur, AIIMS, Patna, AIIMS, Rishikesh, AIIMS, Raipur, AIIMS, Mangalagiri, AIIMS, Gorakhpur, AIIMS, Bathinda, AIIMS, Deoghar, AIIMS, Bibinagar, AIIMS, Nagpur, AIIMS, Bilaspur, AIIMS ,Rai Bareli .
