#### Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Central Institutes of Hotel Management functioning in the country, State/UT-wise;
- (b) whether the Government has failed to set up new hotel management institutes in the country and if so, the details thereof and reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the Government also extends support to State Governments to set up State Institutes of Hotel Management in their respective States;
- (d) if so, the number of such Institutes set up in Maharashtra during each of the last three years and the current year along with financial allocation for this purpose;
- (e) the challenges faced by these institutes while imparting quality education and training to students;
- (f) whether these Institutes have been successful in contributing in the growth of Tourism Sector in the country and if so, details thereof; and
- (g) whether the Government has decided to set up new hotel management institutes besides introduction of hospitality

education through Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) and if so, the details thereof?

#### **ANSWER**

#### THE MINISTER OF TOURISM

(SHRI G. KISHAN REDDY)

- (a): There are 21 Central Institutes of Hotel Management (CIHMs) presently functioning in the country. The details are at Annexure-I.
- (b): No, Sir. Question does not arise.
- (c): Yes, Sir.
- (d): In the last three years and the current year, no Institute has been set up in Maharashtra with the support from the Ministry.
- (e): Challenges are attended to on case to case basis regularly.
- (f): Yes, Sir. These Institutes have been successful in contributing to the growth of tourism sector in the country and play a great role in creating skilled manpower for the tourism and hospitality industry. A statement regarding placement of passed out candidates during the last 5 years is enclosed as Annexure-II.
- (g): Setting up of new hotel management institute is an ongoing process and the Ministry takes necessary decision in this regard as and when proposals are received from the State Govt./UT Administration. Extension of financial assistance for introduction of Hospitality Education through Industrial Training Institutes has been discontinued from the current Financial Year on the recommendation of Standing Finance Committee of the Ministry.
