Nuclear Power Plant in Rajasthan

190. SHRI KANAKMAL KATARA:

Will the PRIME MINISTER be pleased to state:

- (a) the progress report on setting up of a nuclear power plant of 2800 megawatt in Banswara, Rajasthan; and
- (b) the details of funds released so far, for the construction of the said nuclear power plant?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR PERSONNEL, PUBLIC GRIEVANCES & PENSIONS AND PRIME MINISTER'S OFFICE (DR. JITENDRA SINGH):

- (a) At the Mahi Banswara project, land acquisition is at an advanced stage, with about 99% of the Resettlement & Rehabilitation (R&R) award distributed. The various site investigations, construction of boundary wall and construction of Resettlement & Rehabilitation (R&R) colony are underway.
- (b) The expenditure incurred on the project upto September 2022 is about Rs. 547 crore.
