Will the Minister of TRIBAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether minor forest produce is a major source of livelihood and earning cash for tribals and local people of villages in nearby forest areas in the country State-wise including Jharkhand, Darang district in Jharkhand, Assam, Maharashtra, Chhattisgarh and Rajasthan and if so, the total number of people dependent on forests and forest produce in said areas;
- (b) the details of minor forest produce purchased at the minimum support price in the country State-wise along with number of procurement centres set up in the country including States of Jharkhand, Assam, Maharashtra, Chhattisgarh and Rajasthan;
- (c) the number of species of minor forest produce for which minimum support prices have been fixed during the last three years and the arrangements made for storage, processing, transportation and distribution of minor forest produce along with the details thereof; and
- (d) the total number of types of Forest Produce whose support price have been fixed?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR TRIBAL AFFAIRS (SMT. RENUKA SINGH SARUTA)

- (a): Minor Forest Produce (MFP) is a significant forest resource and also an important source of livelihood and earning cash for tribal communities and villagers inhabiting near forest areas, though specific numbers of people dependent on MFP are not maintained in the Ministry of Tribal Affairs.
- (b): The Ministry of Tribal Affairs, Govt. of India has released Rs 319.65 Crores towards revolving funds to the States for procurement of Minor Forest Produce on notified Minimum Support Price under the scheme of 'Mechanism for Marketing of

Minor Forest Produce (MFP) through Minimum Support Price (MSP) and Development of Value Chain for MFP' (now merged under Pradhan Mantri Janjatiya Vikas Mission - PMJVM) against which procurement of Rs.524.35 Crores of MFPs has been undertaken during the financial year 2014-15 to 2022-23. The details of the procurement of MFPs made during last three years by

the State Governments through their State Implementing Agencies (SIAs) along with Procurement centres are given in the **Annexure**.

(c) to (d): 87 MFPs have been notified by the Ministry for Minimum Support Price under the scheme of PMJVM. The details of the 87 MFPs are enclosed at **Annexure**.

The Ministry has also released an amount of Rs. 89.15 Crores to State Implementing Agencies for development of infrastructure facilities such as modernisation of haat bazaars, godowns etc. to facilitate procurement, storage, processing, transportation and distribution activities.
