Plantation of Trees in Villages

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of proposal of the Government for the plantation of trees in villages for soil conservation, better soil productivity;
- (b) whether the Government has earmarked the progress of afforestation in urban and rural areas especially in tribal areas and if so, the details thereof; State-wise; and
- (c) the details of funds provided/proposed to be provided to Rajasthan to promote plantation in the private sector?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE (SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY)

(a)&(b) Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change has been making constant efforts to increase forest and tree cover and has taken several initiatives towards plantation activities which in-turn also help in soil conservation, better soil productivity in the country including villages/rural areas. Afforestation programmes under various Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSS) of the Ministry such as National Afforestation Programme (NAP) and National Mission for a Green India (GIM), are implemented with participatory approach. The funds under Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA), *inter-alia*, is used for forest and wildlife management related activities including compensatory afforestation. The Ministry also promotes tree plantation as people's movement through school nursery and urban forestry programmes. Tree plantation/afforestation being the multi-departmental effort, also taken up cross sectorally by various departments of the Centre and State Governments, Non-Government Organizations, civil society, corporate bodies etc.

Annual afforestation /tree plantation targets are fixed by the Ministry for all States/UTs including rural, urban and tribal areas which are achieved through the concerted efforts. The State/UT wise details of afforestation /tree plantation targets fixed for the year 2022-23 are given in *Annexure*.

(c) There is no such proposal, at present in the Ministry, for providing funds to Rajasthan to promote plantation in the private sector.
