TRIBAL POPULATION OF TELANGANA

1995. SHRI B.B. PATIL:

Will the Minister of TRIBAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government has a record of tribal population, district-wise particularly in the State of Telangana;

(b) whether the Government has any data with regard to migration of tribal population from rural areas to urban areas in search of livelihood; and

(c) the details of the steps taken up by the Government to secure tribal languages and culture?

(a): Data on tribal population in the country is available from the decennial Population Census. District-wise Scheduled Tribes population of Telangana as received from Govt. of Telangana is given in **Annexure**.

(b): Data on migration of tribal population is not maintained centrally by the Ministry. However, as per survey on 'Employment & Unemployment and Migration Particulars' conducted by the National Statistical Office (NSO), Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation during NSS 64th round (2007 - 08), estimated percentage of Scheduled Tribes migration in urban areas from rural areas in search of employment/livelihood/business is as given below:

(c): Ministry of Tribal Affairs is administering two schemes namely "Support to Tribal Research Institutes (TRIs)" and "Tribal Research, Information, Education, Communication and Events (TRI-ECE)". Through the schemes, funds are provided to State Governments to strengthen and support the TRIs inter-alia for research & documentation activities, evidence-based action and applied research to find solution and create replicate models of development, construction and maintenance of tribal museums, organization of tribal festivals, programs for preservation of tribal cultural heritage in dance, music, painting etc. and training and capacity building programs. Further, New Education Policy stipulates that young child learn and grasp quickly in their home language and mother tongue. Accordingly, Central and State Government are making efforts to encourage multi-lingual policy for imparting education and preservation of language.
