Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is considering to open more Kendriya Vidyalayas in Delhi;
- (b) the total number of Kendriya Vidyalayas in Delhi, district- wise; and
- (c) the total number of such Kendriya Vidyalayas which are not yet opened for students after construction?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION (SMT. ANNPURNA DEVI)

- (a) Opening of new Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) is a continuous process. KVs are opened primarily to cater to the educational needs of the wards of transferable Central Government Employees including Defence & Para-military personnel, Central Autonomous Bodies, Central Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) and Central Institute of Higher Learning (IHL) by providing a common programme of education throughout the country. Proposals for opening of new KVs may be sponsored by Ministries or Departments of the Government of India / State Governments / Union Territories (UTs) Administrations, with commitment to provide requisite resources for setting up a new KV as per norms. The proposals are subject to approval of the competent authority. Delhi Development Authority (DDA) has submitted a proposal to Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan for opening of a new KV under civil-sector at Khajuri-Khas of North-East district of Delhi.
- (b) At present, there are 46 KVs functioning in Delhi. District-wise details are annexed.
- (c) Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan has informed that all KVs in Delhi except one at Shahdara have been made functional to students on final completion of the school buildings, after ensuring that the physical infrastructure is complete in all aspects and basic amenities such as potable water, toilets & electricity supply etc. are available. The construction of physical infrastructure of KV Shahdara is at final stage.
