Most Polluted Cities

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has identified the most polluted cities/towns in the country;
- (b) whether the Government has any proposal to stop the increasing pollution level of those cities and towns and if so, the steps taken/proposed to be taken in this regard;
- (c) the details of such cities in the country including the level of pollution increased during the last two years and the reasons therefor, State-wise; and
- (d) whether the Government has devised any strategy to reduce the pollution level in future and if so, the details thereof?

(a), (b),(c) &(d):

Ministry of Environment Forest &Climate Change (MoEF&CC) launched National Clean Air Programme (NCAP) in January, 2019, which is a time-bound, national level strategy for prevention, control and abatement of air pollution. Under NCAP, it has been envisaged to achieve targets of 20 to 30 % reduction in Particulate Matter concentration by 2024 in 131 cities.

NCAP strategy includes the following actions:

- (i) Clean Air Action Plans at National, State and City levels for source specific mitigation actions;
- (ii) Financial incentive structure for targeted cities linked with air quality improvement performance (49 cities under XVth Finance Commission grants and 82 cities funded under NCAP)
- (iii) Coordinated actions by Central Ministries and State Governments and their agencies;
- (iv) Convergence of resources from schemes of Central Government, State Government and Urban Local Bodies;
- (v) Building of a mass movement – Jan Andolan.

Details of air quality status in 131 cities during FY 2020-21 and 2021-22 are enclosed at **Annexure-I**.
