SCHEMES TO DEVELOP INDIA AS TOURISM HUB

2044. SHRIMATI POONAM MAHAJAN:

Will the Minister of TOURISM be pleased to state:

- (a) the various schemes being implemented by the Government with an objective of developing India as a tourism hub, State/Union Territory-wise details thereof;
- (b) the budget earmarked for and the amount spent on the said schemes during the last five years; and
- (c) the steps being taken by the Government to ensure adequate security of foreign tourists in the country?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF TOURISM

(SHRI G. KISHAN REDDY)

- (a): The major schemes implemented by the Ministry of Tourism applicable in all States/Union Territories for developing India as a tourism hub are:
 - i) Swadesh Darshan
 - ii) Pilgrimage Rejuvenation and Spiritual Heritage Augmentation Drive (PRASHAD)
 - iii) Assistance to Central Agencies for Tourism Infrastructure Development
 - iv) Domestic Promotion and Publicity including Hospitality
 - v) Restructured Scheme of Overseas Promotion & Publicity including Market Development Assistance
 - vi) Assistance to IHMs/FCIs/IITTM/ICI/ NCHMCT etc.
 - vii) Capacity Building for Service Providers
 - viii) Champion Services Sector Scheme
 - ix) Safe Tourist Destinations for Women

- (b): The total budget earmarked for the various schemes along with the amount spent thereon during the last five years is given at Annexure.
- (c): Security of tourists is essentially a State Government subject. However, Ministry of Tourism has taken several measures to ensure the safety and security of tourists which are:
 - i. Ministry of Tourism has taken up the matter with all the State Governments/Union Territory(UT) Administrations for providing a safe and secure environment to tourists. In case any such untoward incident occurs against a tourist, there should be a robust system of law & order to handle the situation and provide a satisfactory solution to the affected tourists.
 - ii. With the efforts of Ministry of Tourism, the State Governments /UT Administrations of Andhra Pradesh, Delhi, Goa, Karnataka, Kerala, Maharashtra, Himachal Pradesh, Jammu and Kashmir, Madhya Pradesh, Odisha, Punjab, Rajasthan, Sikkim and Uttar Pradesh have deployed tourist police in one form or the other.
 - iii. Ministry of Tourism got a study conducted by Indian Institute of Tourism & Travel Management (IITTM), an autonomous institute under its control, to understand the requirement of tourist police and sensitizing the tourist police so created towards the needs of the tourists. Ministry of Tourism forwarded a copy of this Study report titled "Functioning of Tourist Police in States/UTs & Documentation of Best Practices" to all the State Governments/UT Administrations with the request to create a separate unit of police in the respective State/UT and also to sensitize them about the needs of the tourists.
 - iv. Ministry of Tourism has been seeking support of the Ministry of Home Affairs for taking up the matter with the State Governments.
 - v. To develop a comprehensive framework, Bureau of Police Research and Development (BPR&D) commissioned a study on Tourist Police Scheme. Ministry of Tourism has organised a National Conference of DGs/IGs of Police Department of the State /UT Administration on 19th

- October, 2022 at New Delhi to implement the uniform Tourist Police Scheme at pan India level.
- vi. The Ministry of Tourism has set up a 24x7 Toll Free Multi-Lingual Tourist Info-Helpline in 12 Languages to provide support service in term of information relating to Travel in India and to offer appropriate guidance to tourists in distress while travelling in India.
- vii. The Ministry of Tourism along with all stakeholders, including the Tourism Departments of all States and UTs, have adopted the 'Code of Conduct for Safe & Honourable Tourism' which is a set of guidelines to encourage tourism activities to be undertaken with respect for basic right like dignity, safety and freedom from exploitation of both tourists and local residents in particular, women and children.
