<u>UTILIZATION OF TAX REVENUE FROM TOBACCO</u>

2070. SHRI M. SELVARAJ:

Will the Minister of FINANCE be pleased to state:

- (a) the total amount of Central Tax collected on tobacco during each of the last three years, State/ UT-wise;
- (b) whether the tax collected from tobacco is used to fund the healthcare sector, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the time by which the Government proposes to start utilizing taxes collected from tobacco for the healthcare sector?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF FINANCE (SHRI PANKAJ CHAUDHARY)

- (a): The information is at Annexure.
- (b) and (c): Taxes collected from tobacco, similar to taxes collected from other sources, together form part of the overall Gross Tax Revenues (GTR) of the Government of India and are used to fund all schemes and programmes of the Government. In Budget 2022-23, an amount of ₹83,000 Crores has been allocated to fund the requirements of the Department of Health and Family Welfare. This will be met from both capital and revenue receipts of the Government of India.
