HOUSES TO HOMELESS PEOPLE UNDER PMAY-G

2075. DR. DHAL SINGH BISEN: SHRI CHANDRA PRAKASH CHOUDHARY:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of homeless people who have been provided housing so far under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Gramin (PMAY-G) during the last three years, State and district-wise particularly in Madhya Pradesh and Jharkhand including Bokaro, Giridih and Dhanbad district;
- (b) the time likely to be taken by the Government to meet the current and future targets fixed under the said yojana in the country including Madhya Pradesh and Jharkhand; and
- (c) whether the Government has prepared any list regarding the number of people who have been provided and those who have not been provided houses under the said yojana and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SADHVI NIRANJAN JYOTI)

(a) The State/UT-wise number of houses built/ constructed under the Pradhan MantriAwaasYojana-Gramin (PMAY-G) in the country during 2019-20 to 2021-22 is at **Annexure-1.** District-wise number of houses built/ constructed in respect of Madhya Pradesh and Jharkhand including Bokaro, Giridh and Dhanbaddisrict, are given at **Annexure-2**. Further, District-wise details of houses constructed under PMAY-G can be seen at the programme website at www.pmayg.nic.in--->AwaasSoft--->Reports---> Houses completed in a financial year irrespective of target year.

(b) & (c) The target is set under PMAY-G, is to construct of 2.95 crore houses to achieve the objective of "Housing for All" in rural areas by March 2024. The target for Madhya Pradesh and Jharkhand are as below:

The beneficiaries under PMAY-G have been identified based on the housing deprivation parameters prescribed under Socio Economic Caste Census (SECC) 2011. After due verification by the Gram Sabha and completion of Appellate Process, Gram panchayat-wise Permanent Wait List (PWL) is prepared. The auto generated priority list of households from SECC, 2011 database was provided to the States/Union Territories (UTs) for conducting Gram Sabha meetings to finalize the PWL. As on 15.12.2022, a total number of 2.08 crore households have been identified and included in PWL from SECC, 2011. Further, the details

of such households who claimed to be left out from the SECC 2011 and eligible for inclusion in PWL, have been captured in the Awaas+ Survey, 2018. The Survey was conducted during January, 2018 and 7th March, 2019. In this exercise, the States/UTs have uploaded details of additional households. In order to fill the gap of 87 lakh houses (2.95 crore - 2.08 crore), Awaas+ data is being utilized. Out of this, a target of 83.83 lakh has been allocated to the States/UTs till date.
