**RURAL HOUSING IN ODISHA**

2078. SHRIMATI APARAJITA SARANGI:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has mapped the rural housing requirements and funds allocated in Odisha;
- (b) the details of funds allocated to improve affordable rural housing infrastructure in Odisha; and
- (c) the details of rural housing targets met by the Government so far in Odisha?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (c) In order to achieve the target of “Housing for All” in rural areas, the Ministry of Rural Development is implementing Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana- Gramin (PMAY-G) with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2016 to provide assistance to eligible rural households with overall target to construct 2.95 crore pucca houses with basic amenities by March, 2024.

In the State of Odisha, the eligible beneficiaries available in SECC based Permanent Wait List (PWL) are 18,58,283 and in Awaas+ are 13,78,312 as on 14.12.2022,. The Ministry has allocated full and final target of 26,95,837 houses to Odisha State (including 8,17,513 from Awaas+ list) from the financial year 2016-17 till 2021-22. Out of which, the Odisha State has sanctioned 18,36,551 houses to beneficiaries and 17,13,511 houses have been completed as on 14.12.2022. In addition, as per the proposal submitted by the state, a Special Project to cover 1,42,005 cyclone FANI affected households registered in Awaas+ has also been sanctioned to Odisha State under PMAY-G.

The Ministry has released an amount of Rs.13,939.98 crore as Central assistance to Odisha State under PMAY-G for construction of targeted houses from the financial year 2016-17 to 2022-23 (as on 14.12.2022).

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
