(c) The Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports is providing financial assistance to recognized National Sports Federations (NSFs) towards training of athletes which includes all requisite facilities for their preparations including wholesome nutritious diet, food supplements, equipment support, state-of-the-art infrastructure, lodging, travelling facilities, services of reputed Indian and Foreign Coaches/supporting staff, scientific & medical support, sports kit, etc. besides financial assistance for their training abroad and participation in international competitions in India and abroad through the Scheme of financial assistance to NSFs. For the said purpose, an Annual Calendar for Training and Competition (ACTC) budget is approved for each NSF every year.

Further, elite Athletes are selected and provided with financial assistance like OPA, equipment Support, coaches etc under the Ministry's Target Olympic Podium Scheme (TOPS).
