### **Sports Facilities**

### 2125. SHRI PALLAB LOCHAN DAS:

Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

(a) the details of various programmes through which the Government extends sports facilities in the country; and

(b) the details of the current facilities available for sportspersons of various disciplines in Assam?

#### ANSWER

# THE MINISTER OF YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS [SHRI ANURAG SINGH THAKUR]

(a) & (b): 'Sports' being a State subject, the responsibility for promotion/development of sports in the country, including providing sports facilities, rests primarily with the respective State/Union Territory (UT) Governments. However, the Central Government through its various Schemes supplements their efforts for promoting/developing sports in the country, which includes extending sports facilities in various states/UTs, viz.:

(i) Khelo India Scheme;

- (ii) Sports Training Centres through the Sports Authority of India (SAI);
- (iii) National Sports Development Fund (NSDF).

Under the Khelo India Scheme, 29 centres in 28 States/UTs are supported as Khelo India State Centres of Excellence along with 733 centres at the district level as Khelo India Centres. Further, 09 Sports Schools and 28 Army Boys Sports Companies (ABSCs) are also supported under the Scheme. In addition, 266Sports Academies have beenaccredited for training of the athletes identified under the Scheme. The details of Khelo India Centres, Khelo India State Centre of Excellence and Accredited Academies in the state of Assam are as under:

Further, under the component "Creation and Upgradation of Sports Infrastructure" of the Khelo India Scheme, 298 sports infrastructure projects have been sanctioned across the country, including 8 in the state of Assam, which cater to sportspersons of various disciplines. The details of these 8 projects are at <u>Annexure</u>.

Under the various sports promotional schemes implemented by SAI, a total of 189 Centres, including National Centre of Excellence (NCOEs), SAI Training Centres (STCs), Extension Centres, etc. are currently functional across the country. 8968 talented athletes (5469 boys and 3499 girls) are undergoing training in 27 sports disciplines and7 Indigenous sports disciplines in residential as well as non-residential categories in these Centres. The details of the above facilities in respect of Assam are as under:

The Government also provides financial assistance for development of infrastructure and other activities for promotion of sports through the NSDF Scheme. During the last five years, 32 projects of various categories have been sanctioned under the NSDF scheme, including 3 in the state of Assam. The details are given at <u>Annexure</u>.
