(a) to (c) The Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying, Government of India is implementing following schemes to supplement the efforts of the States/UTs including Nagaland for promotion and development of the animal husbandry and dairying sector as under:

- i. Rashtriya Gokul Mission,
- ii. National Programme for Dairy Development,
- iii. Dairy Processing and Infrastructure Development Fund,
- iv. Supporting Dairy Cooperatives and Farmer Producer Organizations engaged in dairy activities
- v. National Livestock Mission,
- vi. Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund
- vii. Livestock Health and Disease Control Programme
- viii. Livestock Census and Integrated Sample Survey

Livestock Health & Disease Control Programme is being implemented across the country including Nagaland to improve the animal health by way of implementation of prophylactic vaccination programmes against various diseases of livestock and poultry, capacity building, disease surveillance and strengthening of veterinary infrastructure.

In order to increase accessibility of veterinary services at farmer's doorsteps, funds for Mobile Veterinary Units (MVUs) are provided to the States/UTs including Nagaland. These

MVUs are customized fabricated vehicles for veterinary healthcare with equipment for diagnosis, treatment & minor surgery, audio visual aids and other basic requirements for treatment of animals.

The yearwise details of funds released to Nagaland and utilized under the schemes implemented by the Department of Animal Husbandry and Dairying from 2018-19 to 2021-2022 are as under:
