SKILL TRAINING UNDER MGNREGS

2249. SHRI VISHNU DAYAL RAM:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the aims and objectives to provide skill training to the unskilled labourers engaged under the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS); and
- (b) the details and number of persons targeted to be provided skill development training during the year 2022-23?

(a) The Government of India has launched “Project UNNATI” in December 2019 which intends to upgrade the skill-base of the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (Mahatma Gandhi NREGS) workers, and thereby improve their livelihoods, so that they can move from the current partial employment to full employment through either self employment or wage employment. The Project aims to enhance the skill base of 2 lakh Mahatma Gandhi NREGS beneficiaries.
